#### Our Concern

The continuous exposure of students and staff to microwave radiation from Wi-Fi in schools.

6 hours per day x 195 days per year = 1200 hr/year for 14 years of their life



NO studies showing that long-term exposure to microwave radiation is safe for children.

In fact, increasing evidence of harm.

#### Why Should we be Concerned?

#### **Bioinitiative Report 2012**

- A review of >4,000 studies looking at health risks of radio/microwave frequency radiation.
- Reviewed by 29 independent scientists and health experts.

#### Health Effects Shown in Research:

- Damage to DNA
- Immune system suppression
- Leakage of blood brain barrier
- Disruption to neurological, endocrine, cardiovascular systems
- Impaired cognitive function
- Irreversible infertility

- † Agitation
- Sleep disturbances
- Altered cellular function
- Changes to electrical activity in brain
- Links to Parkinson's & Alzheimer's
- 1 rates of cancer



#### **World Health Organization (WHO)**

Classified EMF emissions (including Wi-Fi) as a Class 2B Possible Carcinogen (2011)

Same category as lead, DDT, gasoline, chloroform, engine exhaust.

#### **European Environment Agency**

Has warned that a delay in reducing exposure from wireless radiation may result in a health crisis greater than those caused by AIDS, smoking, pesticides, asbestos and leaded gasoline <u>combined</u>.





#### The American Academy of Environmental Medicine

Adverse health effects, such as learning disabilities, altered immune responses, headaches, etc. from wireless radio frequency fields do exist and are well documented in the scientific literature.

"Statistics show that we can expect to see an immediate reaction in 3% and delayed effects in 30% of children and teachers" from Wi-Fi. (April, 2013)



## The American Academy of Pediatrics


An organization of 60,000 pediatric doctors.

Recommends the reassessment of radiation standards for wireless devices and the adoption of standards that are protective of children and reflect current use patterns. (2013)

## Safety Code 6

- Created in 1979 to protect federal workers on federal jobsites, <u>not</u> children in schools
- For a 6 min exposure for a 6", 200lb male
- One of the <u>least protective</u> standards in the world
- Does not have the force of law or legislation
- Not mandatory for school boards to adopt

### Safety Code 6 Called into Question

- >50 Canadians MDs supported by >50 international scientists- Letter to Minister of Health (July 2014)
- Canadian Medical Association Journal (May 7, 2015):
  - "Scientists decry Canada's outdated Wi-Fi safety rules"
  - Dr. Hardell quoted as saying these guidelines are "a disaster to public health"
- 190 scientists from 39 countries made an appeal to the United Nations to protect humans and wildlife from wireless technology saying some current international guidelines are not protective enough (May 12, 2015)

Strong scientific evidence that adverse health effects occur well below Safety Code 6:

Strongest evidence: cancer and sperm abnormalities/DNA damage

## Health Canada Warning - 2011

Health Canada "encourages parents to reduce children's RF (radiofrequency radiation) exposure... since children are typically more sensitive" and "there is currently a lack of scientific information regarding the potential health impacts of cell phones on children."

# Workers Compensation Act Occupational Health & Safety Regulation

- 5.57 (1) If a substance identified as any of the following is present in the workplace, the employer must replace it, if practicable, with a material which reduces the risk to workers:
  - (a) ACGIH A1 or A2, or IARC 1, 2A or 2B carcinogen;

Recognizes Electrohypersensitivity (EHS) as a disability on par with sightlessness, being constrained to a wheelchair or any other more recognized form of disability.

"The influence of electrosmog on the human body is a <u>known</u> <u>problem"</u>


- "...clear damage to hereditary material has been demonstrated and there have been indications of an increased cancer risk"

- Aviva Will not insure against liability from electromagnetic fields
