Re: the Royal Society of Canada's Expert Panel Reviewing Safety Code 6.

Dear Dr. Layzell,

Congratulations on your recent appointment as the Expert Panel Secretary, the Committee on Expert Panels for the Royal Society of Canada. I realize it will take some time for you to get current on all your responsibilities. Given that the report from the Expert Panel is expected in March, 2014, I am offering my assistance in helping you get updated on the above file.

C4ST is a national, nonprofit organization promoting the safe use of wireless technology. Our membership and Board of Directors are comprised of Canadian scientists, internet technology executives, industry analysts, legislative researchers and lawyers, among others.

We believe you have inherited a panel that is severely conflicted both financially and ideologically regarding the potential harm of wireless radiation at levels below Health Canada's current Safety Code 6. We understand and expect Expert Panel members to have an opinion on this controversial issue. However, to express that opinion so publicly and relentlessly is not only inappropriate but makes it difficult to believe they will be able to act and vote independently. In addition, there is no balancing perspective from other panel members. As a result, we feel there is a reasonable apprehension of bias in this panel and that its results are pre-determined.

All my correspondence to Dr. Grise was referred to Mr. Flynn. In his most recent letter dated August 20, 2013, Mr. Flynn stated " In the interim, the RSC will not otherwise comment further on the work of the Expert Panel on Safety Code 6 until the panel's final report has been completed, peer-reviewed, and submitted to Health Canada."

Attached is a summary letter to Dr. Demers, the new Expert Panel Chair. I would be willing to meet with you and discuss our concerns. Dr. Layzell, we are asking for a fair and independent review of Health Canada's Safety Code 6. Canadians deserve and expect no less.
